Fang Kecheng is a journalist and columnist focusing on Chinese politics at Southern Weekly 南方周末, one of the most influential newspapers in China. A long-time Internet writer and observer, Fang was nominated “best blogger” by the Deutsche Welle in 2012.

In 2011, Fang founded **CNPolitics.org**, an independent website committed to introducing academic studies on Chinese politics to the Chinese public. It has featured interviews with, among others, Elizabeth Perry, Andrew Nathan, and Joseph Nye, and introduced hundreds of academic works on Chinese politics.

Fang holds a BA and MA from Peking University’s School of Journalism and Communication, and a master’s in human rights from Peking University Law School and Lund University in Sweden. He was a visiting scholar at Chinese University of Hong Kong and has lectured at several universities including Fudan University and Renmin University of China. In 2013, he will start his doctorate at the University of Wisconsin-Madison.
